Australian Catholics' media internship program offers Catholic school students the chance to get hands on experience in journalism and contribute to the Spring edition of our magazine.

This is a unique work experience opportunity for students interested in a career in journalism or publishing.

Apply now to be a guest editor

Our guest editors will spend a week at Jesuit Communications, learning about the publishing process and aspects of writing and editing publications, while planning articles for the 2017 Spring edition. The week will also include presentations and mentoring from professionals in the publishing field.

Application process

The internship program is open to students in Years 10 and 11. Guest editors will need to be based in Melbourne, or have their own accommodation in Melbourne for the week of the program. We will require schools to make arrangements for successful candidates to make the placement under work experience provisions. Students involved will organise their own travel to and from Jesuit Communications' office in Richmond each day, as well as their own lunch. The week will include some time for writing, but the students will be required to complete their stories after the internship ahead of the magazine's deadline in June.

Dates: The program will be held in the week of Monday 15 to Friday 19 May.

Students will also be invited to connect with the team during an introductory session a week before the program, on the afternoon of 8 May.

Students applying for the program should supply:

- An application letter outlining reasons for wanting to be part of the program
- Three samples of their writing
- An email contact and a letter of endorsement from a teacher, with a commitment from the school to make work experience arrangements for students and to make arrangements for the stucent to connect with the team via phone or video conference
- An email address so we can send students information about the week

Applications should be submitted to Jesuit Communications no later than 17 March, via email at editor@australiancatholics.com.au.

Successful students will be notified by the end of Term 1. We shall try to offer unsuccessful candidates other opportunities to contribute to the magazine in the future.
