First created in 1993 as a way to bring inspiring and informative stories about Catholic life into the homes of people in school and parish communities, *Australian Catholics* quickly became the largest circulated Catholic publication

in the southern hemisphere and remains so more than 25 years later. It is also the only national Catholic print publication in Australia.

Reaching communities both in print and online, *Australian Catholics* remains one of the few Catholic publications that speaks to people of all backgrounds and ages.

We connect with communities through the two versions of our print magazine – a schools edition and a parish edition – along with two e-newsletters that seek to support those doing formation on the ground – *Catholic Teacher* and *Parish Life*.

We reach over 8,000 staff in our 600+ subscribed schools

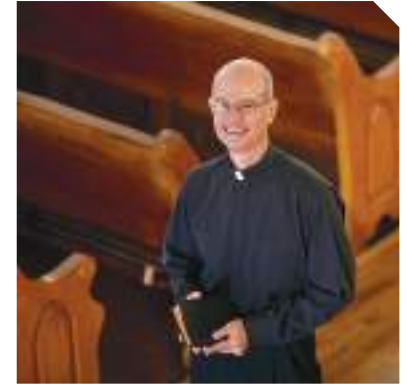

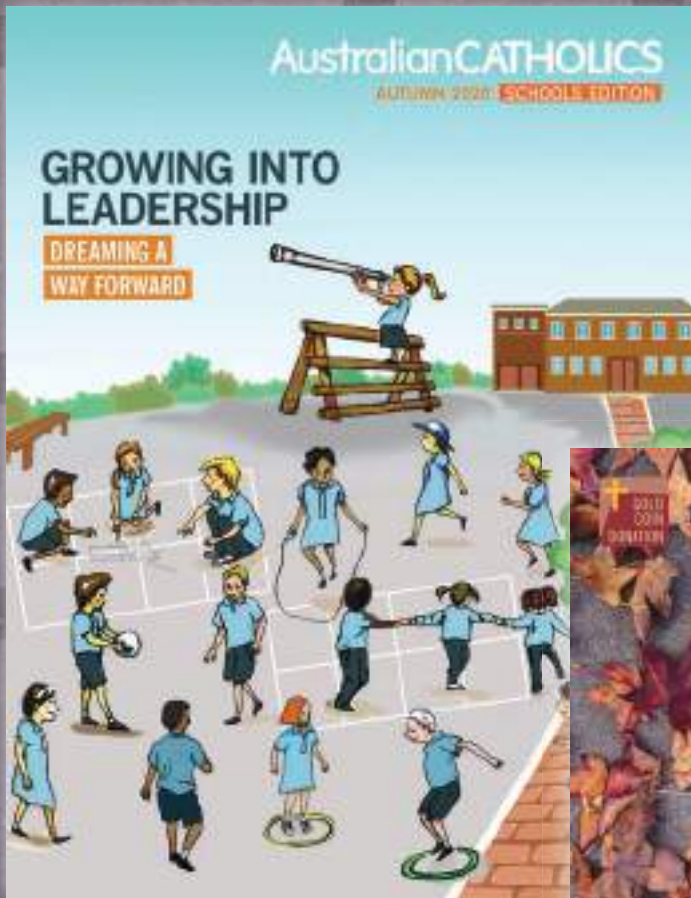


PARISH PRIESTS AND ASSISTANTS

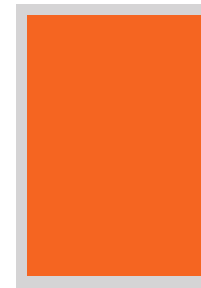

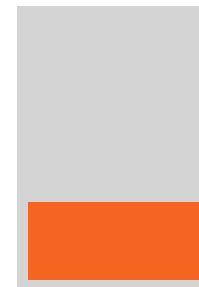
